DESCRIPTION

ERISYS GS-110, the monoglycidyl ester of neodecanoic acid, can be used as a diluent for high viscosity epoxy resins. GS-110 has a low viscosity, low vapor pressure and a less irritating odor than other low viscosity monofunctional diluents. As with all monofunctional aliphatic epoxides, increasing levels of GS-110 in epoxy resins will lengthen gel times and modify cured properties. Some decrease in thermal and chemical resistance and modulus may occur.

ERISYS GS-110 can also be used as a monomer in the production of polyester, acrylic, and alkyd resins. These resins are produced by the reaction of GS-110 with carboxylic acid groups. The resins exhibit improved wetting, gloss, flexibility and salt spray resistance.

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



HEALTH & SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

ERISYS GS-110 is not a primary skin irritant or sensitizer. However, as with any epoxy material, irritation can result from repeated or prolonged contact. PACKAGING & AVAILABILITY

ERISYS GS-110 is available in 55 gal. non-returnable steel drums (net weight 445 lbs.) and 5 gal. plastic pails (40 lbs. net). Bulk shipments are available with adequate lead- time.
